

Cesare Conti is a professor in Corporate Finance in the Department of Finance at Bocconi University in Milan, where is the director of the Master of Science in Finance and teaches “Corporate Finance”, “Corporate Valuation” and “Financial & Enterprise Risk Management”.

He is an independent consultant, independent technical consultant and expert witness for companies (CTU/CTP), banks, private equity funds, public bodies, and law/professional firms in the following areas: company valuations, financial instruments and derivative products; business plan asseverations; acquisition financing, financing, refinancing and debt restructuring operations; stipulation-restructuring-closing of derivative products to hedge financial risks on interest and exchange rates.
